



U.S. ATLAS Project Progress- 4th Quarter FY 2003

Above- Both half-barrel Electromagnetic calorimeter cylinders have been assembled and inserted into the cryostat (a U.S. ATLAS deliverable). The more than 110k channels have been warm-tested, with only 12 dead channels. The next steps are the insertion of the solenoid, and a full cold test, planned for early 2004.
